

' Brigadoon '

is new choice

Members of Chelmsford Amateur Operatic and Dramatic Society chose "Brigadoon" as their musical show for next year, at a meeting on Monday.

Their original choice of "The Pajama Game" was dropped because the public's reaction to this idea was "not good."

"Brigadoon"—music and lyrics by the same composer and writer of "My Fair Lady"—offers much wider scope for those taking part. It has dancing, singing, room for acting and comedy.

A different type of show to the Society's two previous productions, it is set in Scotland and New York.

Members also considered the presentation of a straight play this year.

It was felt, however, that after a lapse of several years away from this particular field, it would be best to start off with three one-act plays, and a sub-committee was formed to consider the matter.
